8. Safety Essentials



- Smoke Detectors (battery-operated or hardwired, in each room)
- Carbon Monoxide Detector (in kitchen or near gas appliances)
- Fire Extinguisher (easily accessible, in kitchen or hallway)
- First Aid Kit (band-aids, antiseptic wipes, painkillers, allergy tablets)
 Flashlight (with spare batteries)
- Lockbox (key lockbox for secure check-in)
